

Scouting Report: SAMUEL HUSKIN

Samuel Huskin, born in 2008, is a highly promising central defender who has just signed a two-year contract with Västra Frölunda, one of Sweden's most historic clubs. Standing at 190 cm, Huskin possesses the physical presence and attributes that define the modern centre-back. Strong, fast, and aggressive in his defensive approach, he thrives in direct duels and relishes physical battles. His aerial dominance is a standout feature, making him a reliable asset in both defensive and attacking set-piece situations.

Huskin plays with a simple, no-nonsense style that prioritizes security and stability at the back. He is vocal and communicative, organising the defensive line. While his natural role is as the central anchor in a back three, his combination of athleticism and adaptability allows him to perform effectively in any position across a three- or four-man defence.

Defensively, his speed enables him to track runners in behind and cover wide areas when required, while his strength allows him to win duels both on the ground and in the air. His game is built on directness and efficiency, avoiding unnecessary risks.

Areas for development lie in his defensive positioning and work with the ball, where improvement in anticipation and distribution could further elevate his overall impact. However, given his age, physical gifts, and mentality, the potential ceiling is exceptionally high. With the right coaching and environment, Huskin has the tools to progress to the highest levels of European football in the years ahead.
